## Intent

Our Sports Premium allowance for the academic year 2022-23 is £17,780 based on 197 eligible pupils. We endeavour to see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators:

Indicator 1: the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school

Indicator 2: the profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement

Indicator 3: increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport

Indicator 4: broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils

Indicator 5: increased participation in competitive sport
