			God the Holy Spirit Gospels	God the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity in Christianity.  The four biblical narratives covering the life and death of Jesus Christ Written by Matthew, Mark, Luke, John.  In Christianity, salvation is the saving of the soul
				from sin and its consequences.
	John the Baptist	John preached about God's Final Judgment and baptized repentant followers in preparation for it. He was the cousin of Jesus and Jesus was baptised by him.	Good News	The news of the imminent coming of the Kingdom of God through the work of Jesus on the cross and his resurrection from the dead which brings reconciliation between people and God.
	Disciples	A personal follower of Jesus during his life, especially one of the twelve Apostles.	Baptism	The religious rite of sprinkling water onto a person's forehead or of immersion in water, symbolizing purification or regeneration and admission to the Christian Church.
