Our Year 3 class took part in a Titanic Workshop on Wednesday this week. They had great fun re-enacting the Titanic voyage.



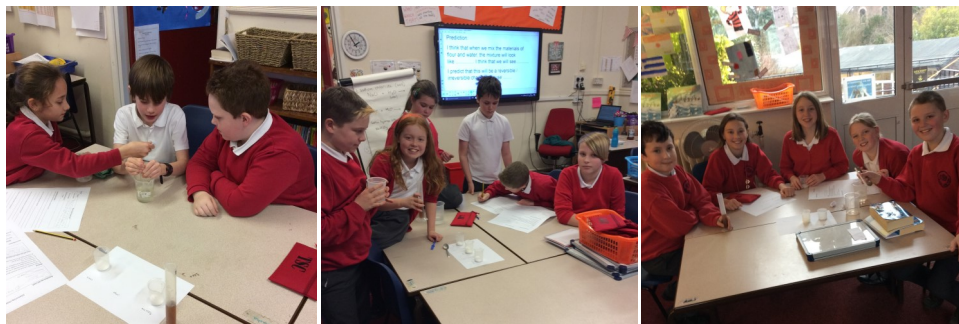
Parking
