Thinking of different of ways to solve things

I am noticing that in class some children are not always trying to solve some of their own problems. Please have a chat at home about this. Thank you.

Home learning diaries:



In phonics last week we have been focusing on the sounds: l, ll, ss

We will be focusing on writing adjectives to describe fireworks this week (I know it seems early but we won't be at school over the Bonfire celebrations). We will be mimicking the sounds by making big splashes in the water, popping with bubble wrap on the writing table and using the black playdoh to describe the different colours in the night sky. These activities will help us think of great descriptive words, for example, 'pop', 'bang', 'snap', 'bright' which we will be able to sound out and write labels. Let's see if they can sound out words using sparklers on Bonfire Night over the Half term if they are allowed to hold one or why not try making firework pictures on the computer and label it with adjectives.

In Maths this week we will be practising recognising different numbers. Some activities you could do at home are: have numbered pots and putting the right amount of sticks in each pot, recognising numbers and using big pens to dot them when the number has been recognised, painting/colouring by number, etc.
