What a super start to our Spring term last week. The children have come in ready to learn and so far have been loving our Superheroes topic. As a little treat at the end of the term they have asked if they could have a Superhero dress up day so keep your eyes peeled for more details on that to follow shortly. Last week we read the Superhero story Supertato by Sue Hendra. The children LOVED it so we will be basing a lot of our learning on it over the next few weeks. Why not ask your child about the story and why they liked it? One of the character's gets into all sorts of mischief in the story and I'm sure he will be causing a little mischief in our class too!

This week we are getting better at:

- Listening with our eyes and our ears.
- Knowing positional words
- Retelling the Supertato story

Our Circle time focus this week is...

Listening with our eyes and our ears.



We have been learning about how important it is to listen using our ears and looking at the person that is talking to you.

Home learning diaries:

In phonics this week we are recapping the sounds: i, m, n, d

This week's tricky words are: said, have

We will be learning all about different positional words this week. To help us with this we will be going on a Supertato and Evil Pea hunt. On the hunt the children will need to record where they find the different vegetables and describe it's position eg. next to the flower bed, beside the box, above the bench, underneath the fence, in front, behind, etc. Why not make a hunt up yourself at home and use these positional words or make an instructions game that encourages the use of positional words, for instance tidying their room: put the teddy beside the toy box, etc.

As we loved reading the story Supertato last week, this week we will be retelling the story so encourage lots of story like language and break it down into beginning, middle and end.

Key vocabulary this week: next, beside, above, underneath, in front, behind, beginning, middle, end, story, characters, events
