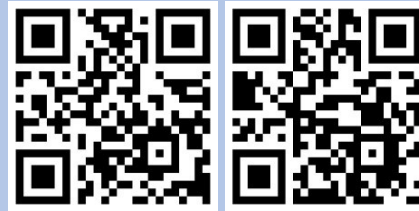
<b>This term's theme</b>	<b>Buglawton Primary School &amp; Monarchs</b>
