Y3	<b>Parking – Inconsiderate and dangerous parking around school</b>	Drives being blocked, are we utilising the Church House enough? Is it possible to have a lollipop person, reduced speed limit? AK spoke about challenges we face with improving parking. Pick up on a Thursday is a challenge because an event at the Church finishes at a similar time.
