



Join the Buglawton 50:50 Club!

How would you like to help your PTA raise funds easily?! Buglawton PTA is offering you an exciting opportunity to be entered into a prize draw each month.

It's very simple... All you have to do is buy a minimum monthly stake of £2. You can increase your chances of winning with the more stakes you purchase. Each month £1 from each stake goes into a prize fund, and the remaining £1 goes towards the PTA funds. Easy and stress free!

A draw will take place each month with one lucky winner taking 50% of the prize funds, with a further two cash prizes of 25%. The more people who join the 50:50 Club and the more stakes people buy, the bigger the prize fund will be each month. So for example, if we have 100 members, and each member buys a £2 stake, then the monthly prize fund will be £100; 1st prize wins £50, 2nd prize is £25 and 3rd prize gets £25. £100 goes into the PTA funds to be spent on the children at the School.

The money that is donated to the PTA fund can be gift aided, so if you are a UK taxpayer you can help us raise even more money by filling in the gift aid form.

You have got to be in it to win it! - Any parent / legal guardian / member of school staff can join or increase their number stakes at any time. Each stake is assigned a unique number. A draw takes place on the second Friday of each month for all paid-up members in the presence of representatives of the school senior management team and the PTA. If the draw date falls during school holidays, the draw will take place on the next school day. Winners will be notified by the school office by phone / text. Prizes can be picked up from the school office from 3 pm that day.

What to do next...

If you want to become a member of the Buglawton 50:50 Club then please complete the enclosed forms, provide the school office with your **mobile number**, so that we can notify you when you win. The **standing order** can be set up online or passed to your bank - and if you are a UK taxpayer, then please help us to increase our funds further by completing **the gift aid form**. A full set of terms and conditions is included.

Terms and conditions of the Buglawton 50:50 Club

1. The club is open to any parent or legal guardian who has children at the school, and to any member of staff who works at the school.
2. Members can join the 50:50 Club or increase their stake at any time.
3. To reduce the amount of administration the monies must be paid into the PTA account by standing order on the 1st day of each month. We cannot accept money by cash or cheque since all the administration is carried out by volunteers.
4. Each member who pays into the fund will be allocated a unique number for each stake they purchase; these numbers will remain unique to that member until the member withdraws from the club.
5. The prize draw will take place on the 2nd Friday of each month.
6. The administrator will check to see if all members have paid monies into the PTA account before the draw takes place. If monies have not been paid into the account before the draw takes place, then those stake numbers will be removed from the draw.
7. The draw will take place in the school, in the presence of one member of the PTA and one member of the senior management team of the school. The winning numbers will be chosen using a random number generator.
8. The winners will be notified by telephone/text on the day of the draw. The money will be available for collection at the school office at 3pm on the day of the draw and must be collected before the next draw takes place, any outstanding prize monies will be donated to the PTA fund.
9. If the date of the draw takes place during a school holiday or when the school is closed for any reason, the draw will take on the first day that the school reopens.
10. The administrator is currently Katharine Jones (PTA Treasurer).
11. Members of the PTA committee are currently Rebecca Jackson (Chair), Alison Kennerley (Secretary) and Katharine Jones (Treasurer).
12. Members of the school's Senior Leadership Team are currently Miss A Kennerley (Headteacher), Mr R Jervis (Deputy Headteacher), Mrs S Murray (SENDCO) and Mrs N Catterall (School Business Manager).
