£1,600

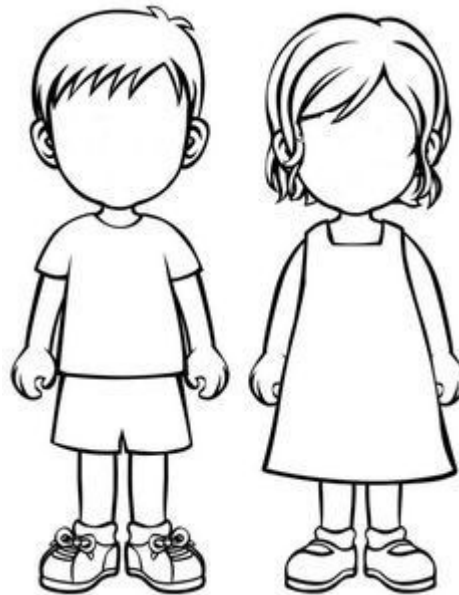
To support children with emotional needs and to build relationships..
