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## Entry Requirements

There are no specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification. However, learners may find it helpful if they have already achieved a level 1 qualification and had some experience of working in childcare, education or health and care setting. All prospective learners will have an interview to ensure the course is suitable for them.

All learners must be at least 16 years old

## How is the course assessed?

**You will be assessed by your tutor using a range of methods. This is a knowledge only qualification; therefore, no real work environment placement is required. To achieve the qualification, you are required to complete 5 mandatory units. You will produce a portfolio of evidence.**

Unit 1 – Understand children and young people's mental health in context

Unit 2 – Understand factors which may affect children and young people's mental health

Unit 3 – Understand children and young people's mental health concerns

Unit 4 – Understand the impact of children and young people's mental health concerns

Unit 5 – Understand how to support children and young people with mental health concerns
