This term's theme: Extreme Environments

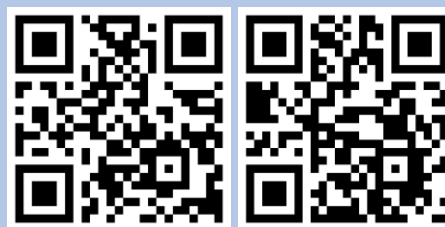
Literacy	The Promise, The Lost Book of Adventure, War of the Worlds. Diary, Newspaper report, Science Fiction narrative, Survival Guide
